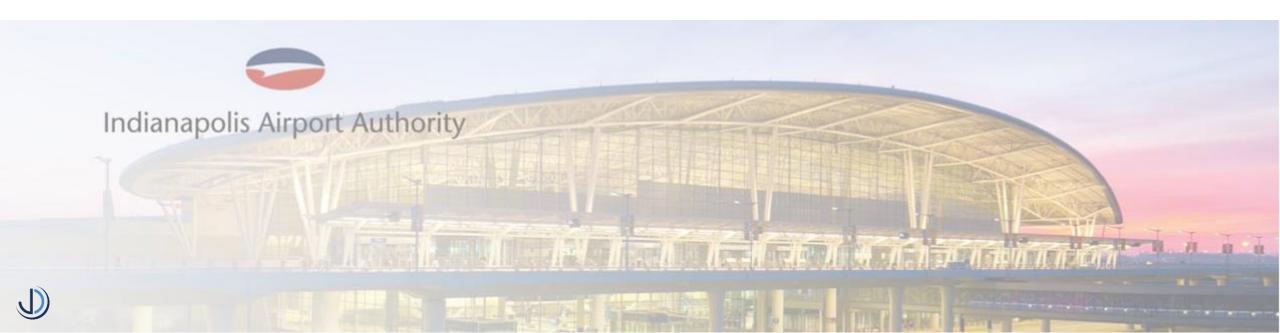

#### DBE PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- The Department of Transportation's (DOT) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program is implemented by recipients of DOT Federal Financial Assistance.
- Recipients are primarily state highway, transit, and airport agencies that receive funds subject to Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations part 26 (49 CFR 26).
- This part seeks to achieve several objectives:
  - o To ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of DOT-assisted contracts in the Department's highway, transit, and airport financial assistance programs;
  - o To create a level playing field on which DBEs can compete fairly for DOT-assisted contracts;
  - o To ensure that the Department's DBE program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law;
  - o To ensure that only firms that fully meet this part's eligibility standards are permitted to participate as DBEs;
  - o To help remove barriers to the participation of DBEs in DOT-assisted contracts;
  - o To promote the use of DBEs in all types of federally-assisted contracts and procurement activities conducted by recipients.
  - o To assist the development of firms that can compete successfully in the marketplace outside the DBE program; and
  - o To provide appropriate flexibility to recipients of Federal financial assistance in establishing and providing opportunities for DBEs.



#### DBE GOAL METHODOLOGY OVERVIEW

- Determine Local Market Area
  - o Identify the counties where a significant percentage of bidders and contractors are located from historical Airport Improvement Projects (AIP)
- Establish Step 1 Base Goal:
  - Calculate relative availability of DBEs compared to all firms within the local market area for each type of anticipated work for future AIP
  - Weight the relative availability of DBEs for each type of anticipated work by the percentage share of estimated spend
- Apply Step 2 Adjustment:
  - Determine the median DBE past accomplishment from the last five years
  - Average the Step 1 Base Goal with the median past accomplishment to arrive at the DBE Goal



## LOCAL MARKET AREA

The top eight counties by historical number of bidders and spend were identified as the local market area.

These counties represent 93.1% of bidders and 91.2% of spend for Airport Improvement Projects from FY 2016-2018

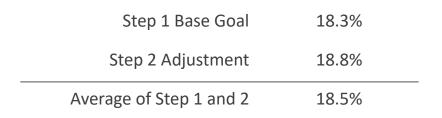
